Chapter 6 <i>Medical Control Policies</i>	Section 2 <i>BEMSP Notification</i>

**Relevant Information:** UFA EMTs and Paramedics are licensed by the State of Utah Bureau of Emergency Medical Services & Preparedness (BEMSP). BEMSP requires that they be notified in the event a person licensed by BEMSP is arrested, charged, incarcerated, or convicted of criminal activity. BEMSP will evaluate the circumstances and may restrict or revoke the license of that individual.

**Policy Statement:** It is the policy of the Board that within twenty-four hours of the occurrence, and before returning to duty, any BEMSP certified/licensed UFA employee is required to notify the EMS Division Chief about any arrest, charge, incarceration, or conviction as defined by BEMSP in its administrative rules.
