If civil drawings are not available, 8.5x11 sketched drawings will be accepted but must be legible and include the following information.

Please specify the following on the Site Plan:

- Location of tank(s) and piping.
- Distance from adjacent buildings
- Distance from property lines.
- Distance from adjacent equipment.
- Adjacent streets
- Type of barricades (LPG and AST).
- Distance from existing tanks.
- Distance from fuel dispensers.
- Proposed sampling locations and depths.
- Utilities located on the site (sewer, power, gas).
- Other important features.
