Jayne McConnellogue is a 23-year veteran of the Colorado Springs Fire Department currently serving as the Deputy Chief of Operations, where she is responsible for the emergent and non-emergent 911 response for the City of Colorado Springs. This response is managed by 467 sworn firefighters in varying ranks operating out of 23 fire stations. She is also responsible for the Medical and Community and Public Health Divisions that staff 25 civilians, 7 sworn staff, and a team of 8 Medical Directors.

Prior to her appointment to Deputy Chief, Jayne served 5 years as the Battalion Chief of the Medical Division and the Community and Public Health Division, where she was responsible for the emergency medical system and was committed to developing, improving, and leading the delivery of medical care in the community and region. In the Community and Public Health Division, she set the vision to professionally and compassionately help people receive the right care, at the right time, with the right resource, for the right cost through multiple innovative programs.

Jayne has risen through the ranks beginning her career in 1998 as a Firefighter and then promoting to Paramedic, Lieutenant, Captain, Battalion Chief and now currently serving as Deputy Chief. She was appointed to the state-wide Responder Strong Advisory Board and the Advisory Board for the Colorado Professional Fire Fighters and has been a committee member to the Colorado State Fire Chiefs Health, Safety, and Survivability Committee. Within the CSFD, she has passionately served as a member and as the executive coordinator of the CSFD Peer Support Team since 2006. Throughout her career, Jayne has continually sought out ways to be involved in ensuring and enhancing the safety and wellness, not only for first responders and the firefighting community, but also for the citizens of Colorado Springs.
