A delivery shift is 8-10 hours over the course of a day. Delivery teams will be expected to work at least one day a month, and the EMS Division is asking for a minimum of 1 year commitment to be considered for the team.

This assignment requires attention to detail. Previous performance with the current CheckIt system will be considered as well as current shift and scheduling availability when evaluating candidates.
