SUBJECT: Ambulance Relocation Bumps

Effective July 1, 2024, the part-time ambulance from Station 104 will be relocated to Station 106 (MA206), and the full-time ambulance from Station 106 will be relocated to Station 104 (MA104). Due to this operational change, there will be bumps for the senior Paramedic and senior Firefighter bids at Station 106. On **May 20, 2024**, Staffing will begin taking bumps for the following positions and individuals: MA106 Firefighter and Paramedic. The bumps will be conducted according to Policy 400-120 Bids, Bumps, and Assignments <https://powerdms.com/link/unifiedfire/document/?id=1817423>.

Bumps start with the senior member in each rank. If a bumped member has more seniority than a member already on the list, that bumped member will be placed into the appropriate position based on seniority, so there will not be any member experiencing a double bump.

Personnel will have 48 hours to make their selection and can bump into any position for which they are qualified and have seniority. Members may also elect to return to the rove, forgoing their bid.

Members receiving bids are in order of initial seniority:

Those personnel exercising the bumps have 48 hours to execute their bump, it is encouraged that members move quickly to facilitate a smooth process.

Bumps will be conducted starting with senior Paramedic (Bentley) and Firefighter (Love) at 0900 on May 20, 2024. Staffing will call each member and inform them of their bump.

All bumps will be effective July 1.
