SUBJECT: Special Operations Vacancy (Heavy Rescue Program)

There is a vacant Engineer position in the Heavy Rescue Program at Station 121C. In accordance with the Professional Development Plan, interested Engineer Specialists will be required to:

- Submit a resume/work history and cover letter for consideration
- Candidates may go through an interview process with internal evaluators

The preferred candidates will have Heavy Rescue Technician certifications in rope, trench, confined space, extrication, and FEMA Structure Collapse. These certifications are not required but are preferred. If the selected Engineer does not have these certifications, he/she will be expected to obtain the certifications within one year of selection or as soon as they are offered.

If you are a currently promoted Engineer Specialist and are interested in being considered for this position, please apply through Applicant Pro, answer the questions, and upload your resume and cover letter detailing your interest in the position **prior to 5:00 p.m. on November 8, 2024**. Documents will be forwarded to Special Operations Captain Chad Green following the closing date. At that point, you will be provided with additional information regarding the process for selection.
