SUBJECT: Medic Ambulance 107

Starting January 2025, Station 107 in Kearns will be staffed with a full-time medic ambulance. This new unit will enhance coverage for the City of Kearns and help reduce the call volume currently managed by MA109.

Positions for each platoon on MA107 will be included in the November bid process. Personnel assigned to MA107 will remain on the ambulance, as it will not be rotated with a heavy apparatus each shift. Those selected for MA107 will handle their administrative responsibilities (such as timecards, evaluations, and training) under the guidance of the Captain at Station 109.

Additionally, the UFSA Board has recommended a tax increase in the proposed budget to support expanding service at Station 107 with a four-person engine crew. If approved, the addition of the Engine at Station 107 is expected in 2025, with a specific start date to be determined following budget finalization.

We're excited to expand our service in Kearns and are grateful for the support from the UFA Board and UFSA Board in the process. For any questions, please reach out to your Battalion Chief through the appropriate chain of command.
