SUBJECT: Wildland Classes Delivery

The purpose of this memo is to inform you of 2025 NWCG Wildland classes that will be held at Station 120 and online.

- S-215 Fire Operations in the Wildland Urban Interface - Instructor led at Station 120
- S-219 Ignition Operations - On-line and Instructor led at Station 120
- S-270 Basic Air operations - Instructor led at Station 120
- S-131 Fire Fighter type 1 - Instructor led at Station 120
- S-211 Portable Pumps and water use - Instructor led at Station 120
- S-260 Interagency Incident Business Management (online) - Follow link below
- S-290 Intermediate Wildland Behavior (online) - Follow link below
- IS-200 Basic Incident Command System for Initial Response (online) FEMA

Utilize the sign-up sheet link below to sign up for each individual class or log into LMS and find the specific file in the file center under Wildland training (the sign-up sheet is auto saved). All classes will be capped at 20 students. A one-hour break will be given.

S-215 Fire Operations in the Wildland Urban Interface - This is an NWCG-certified instructor-led course. Instructional units include firefighter safety in the interface, managing human factors in the interface, pre-incident planning, size-up and initial strategy, structure triage, structure protection overview, tactics in the interface, tactical operations and resource use in the interface, action assessment, plan update, and after-action review. S-219 Firing Operations - This is an NWCG-certified blended course (estimate 2 hours online and 16 hours of ILT). Students are required to complete the online training portion of the course prior to taking the ILT (Instructor Led Training). This Blended Course Work is available in the NWCG Wildland Fire Learning Portal (WFLP). Log on as a guest to search for this course or go directly to <https://wildlandfirelearningportal.net/course/view.php?id=593>. The course introduces the roles and responsibilities of a Firing Boss, Single Resource (**FIRB**), and outlines duties of other personnel who may engage in firing operations. The course discusses and illustrates common firing devices and techniques. Click on hyperlink for sign-up roster, dates and times of the instructor-led component. [S-219 sign-in sheet](#).

S-270 Basic Air Operations. This course covers aircraft types and capabilities, aviation management and safety for flying in and working with agency aircraft, tactical and logistical uses of aircraft, and requirements for helicopter take-off and landing areas. Required pre-course work is to read the [Basic Aviation Safety](#) publication to become familiar with important terms and concepts (estimate 1 hour).

S-131 Firefighter Type 1 – This course is designed to meet the training needs of the Firefighter Type 1 (FFT1) and/or Incident Commander Type 5 (ICT5). Topics include operational leadership, communications, LCES, and tactical decision-making. [S-131 sign-in sheet](#).

S-211 Portable Pumps and Water Use. This course is designed to provide knowledge and skills to design, setup, operate, troubleshoot, and shut down portable water delivery systems. The focus is on portable pumps – it does not address water delivery for engines. Topics covered include portable water delivery systems, equipment, roles and responsibilities, system design and hydraulics. There is also a field exercise where students will apply what they learned in the classroom. [S-211 sign-in sheet](#).

S-260 Interagency Incident Business Management. This course is available in the [NWCG Wildland Fire Learning Portal \(WFLP\)](#). Log on as a guest to search for this course or go directly to: [S-260 Online](#). Create a profile or log-in to self-enroll. The NFA Online learning management system will track your progress. Keep the certificate as proof of successful completion of the course.

S-290 Intermediate Wildland Fire Behavior. Complete the [online course](#). You will be directed to the COMET MetEd website. You will need a COMET MetEd account before starting the course. To receive an NWCG certificate of completion for this course, follow directions on the COMET MetEd website to obtain an account. It is important to read the [Overview tab](#) on the COMET MetEd website regarding additional requirements about NWCG course certificate. Print the NWCG certificate of completion per the COMET MetEd directions. Keep the certificate as proof of successful completion of the course.

IS 200 Basic Incident Command System for Initial Response is equivalent to ICS-200 AH - ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents. [IS-200 FEMA class](#) is online. Follow this link for [NIMS Courses Accepted by NWCG](#).
