SUBJECT: Primary Children's Hospital Behavioral Health Center-Taylorsville

Primary Children's Hospital Behavioral Health Center – Taylorsville Campus will be open to receive pediatric behavioral health patients starting Saturday, September 6, 2025. This facility will be able to receive patients up to 18 years of age who are experiencing behavioral emergencies.

Pediatric patients experiencing a mental health or behavioral crisis who do not require medical intervention should be transported to this facility instead of a hospital emergency department. Make sure to **call the facility and/or MCOT PRIOR TO SCENE DEPARTURE** as opposed to enroute to the hospital.

Utilizing this facility instead of a hospital ED represents best practice and should be considered even when the behavioral receiving facility is farther away.

The General Transport Criteria EMS protocol will be updated to specify transport to this facility.
