SUBJECT: Special Operations Vacancies (Hazardous Materials Program) Paramedic

There are three vacant Paramedic positions in the Hazardous Materials Program. In accordance with the Professional Development Plan, interested Paramedic Specialists will be required to:

- Submit a resume/work history and cover letter for consideration

The preferred candidate will be certified as a Utah State Hazardous Materials Technician. This certification is not required but is preferred. If the selected Paramedic Specialist does not have this certification, he/she will be expected to obtain certification within one year or as soon as a qualified course is offered.

If you are a Paramedic Specialist or Specialist with a Paramedic certification and are interested in being considered for this position, please submit your interest through iSolved) **no later than June 18, 2026**.
