SUBJECT: Special Operations Vacancy (Hazardous Materials Program) Paramedic

There are three vacant Paramedic positions in the Hazardous Materials Program:

- 2 at Station 126C
- 1 at Station 124A

In accordance with the Professional Development Plan, interested Paramedic Specialists will be required to:

- Submit a resume/work history and cover letter for consideration
- Candidates may go through an interview process with internal evaluators

The preferred candidate will be certified as a Utah State Hazardous Materials Technician. This certification is not required but is preferred. If the selected Paramedic Specialist does not have this certification, he/she will be expected to obtain certification within one year as soon as a qualified course is offered.

If you are a promoted Paramedic Specialist and are interested in being considered for this position, please submit your interest through iSolved Talent Acquisition (formerly ApplicantPro) by October 2, 2026. Documents will be forwarded to Special Operations Captain Chad Green following the closing date. At that point, you will be provided with additional information regarding the process for selection.
