  - > Applicants must pass a background check
  - > Applicants must have a valid driver's license by the time of employment

## The 6-Step Checklist.

- Step 1: Written exam
  - Step 2: Oral board assessment
  - Step 3: Interview and physical test
  - Step 4: Background check
  - Step 5: Firefighter job offer
  - Step 6: Start recruit camp

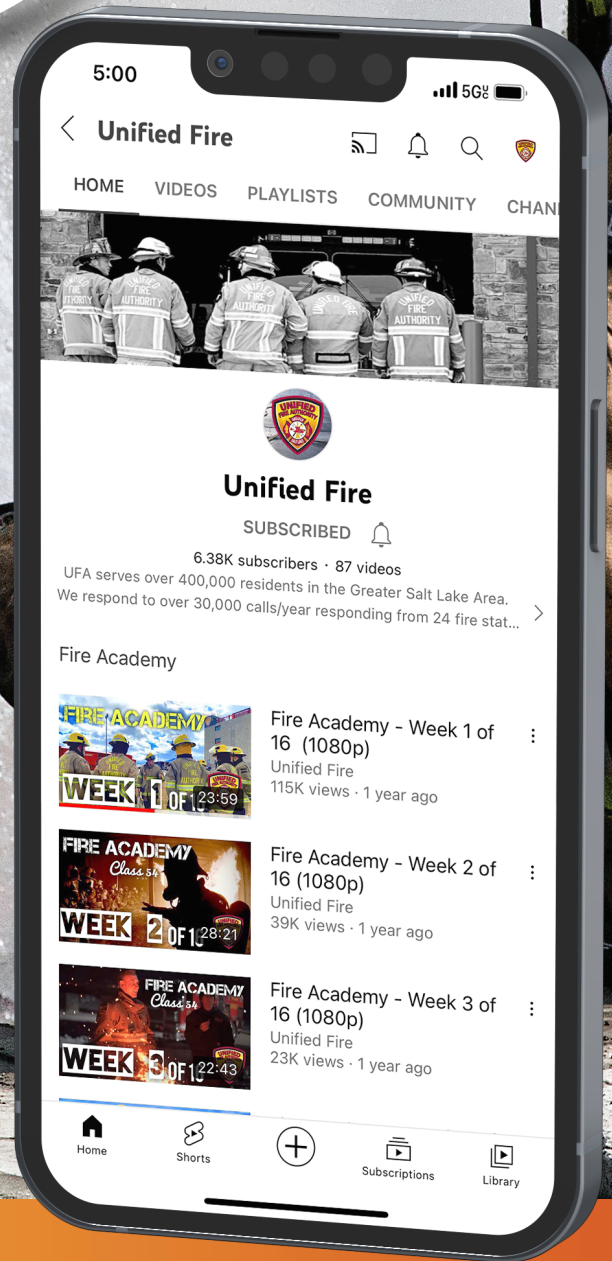
